Today, we celebrate the feast of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ. We are called to reflect and renew our faith in the saving nourishment of the Eucharist. At the Last Supper, Jesus broke the bread and poured the wine, instructing his disciples not only to eat and drink in his memory, but to do so with others who would believe. All that he was, he wanted to give to the world. And as he foretold in the distribution of the loaves and fishes, each of us who receives him is to give him as well.

The Catechism of the Catholic Church defines the Eucharist this way: "The Eucharist is a sacrifice of thanksgiving to the Father, a blessing by which the Church expresses her gratitude to God for all his benefits, for all that he has accomplished through creation, redemption, and sanctification. Eucharist means first of all 'thanksgiving'" (CCC 1360). As we approach the altar prepared to receive the body and blood of Christ, perhaps we would do well to remember the sacrifice he gave for us-his very life. In doing so, we realize that sense of thanksgiving that embodies the Eucharist.

ST. JOSEPH'S YOUTH MINISTRY CATHOLICS IN ACTION

Ministry with the young people at St. Joseph's Parish has many components including service, prayer, leadership development, faith building, and community building. This summer we are going on a mission trip, and a leadership conference. These experiences will develop teens to make a difference for their Churches, schools, and communities.

June 26-28 twelve teens will be attending the Youth Leadership Conference along with 800 other youth from the Joliet Diocese. They will spend three days strengthening their faith, and being developed as leaders by some of the biggest names in Ministry. This conference has been going strong for over 25 years, and continues to change lives that change the world.

On Saturday, July 18th 2009, six adults and twenty teens from the St. Joseph Church Youth Ministry will take place in a week long Catholic HEART Workcamp Mission Trip in Pittsburgh, PA to do home repairs, work at daycares, food pantries, and homeless shelters. The Workcamp mission is to revitalize communities and beautify homes for the elderly, disabled and those who cannot afford needed repairs. Their goal is to inspire participants to serve in their local communities and to empower participants to live as Disciples of Christ through serving others.

We are asking Parish members and area businesses to help by sponsoring us.
